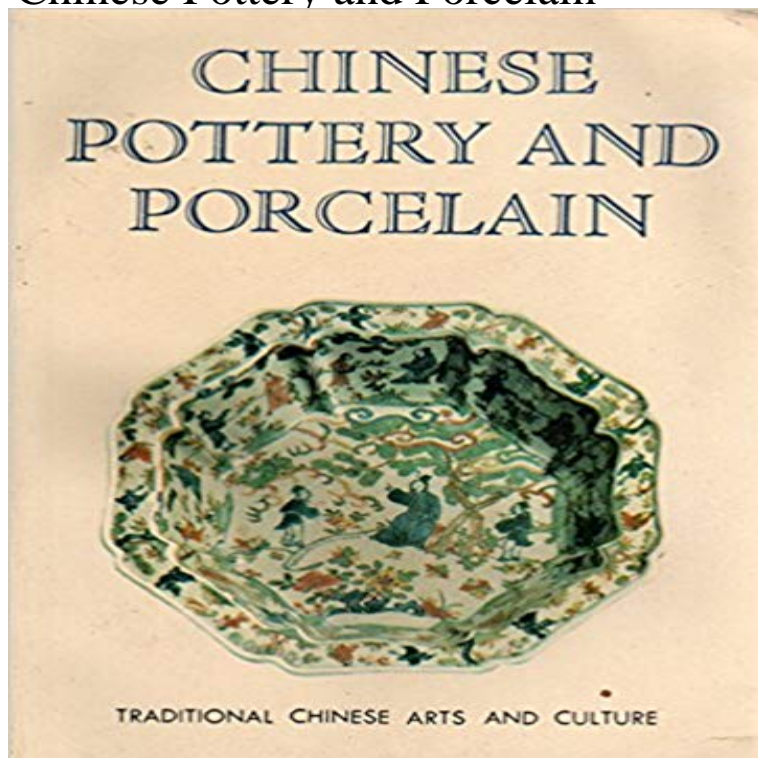


## Chinese Pottery and Porcelain
