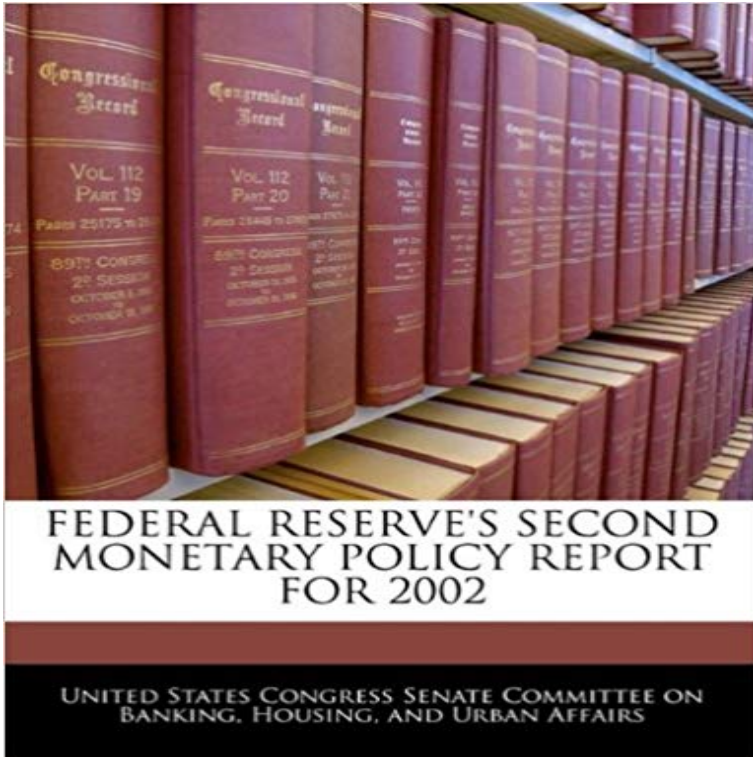


FEDERAL RESERVES SECOND MONETARY POLICY REPORT FOR 2002
