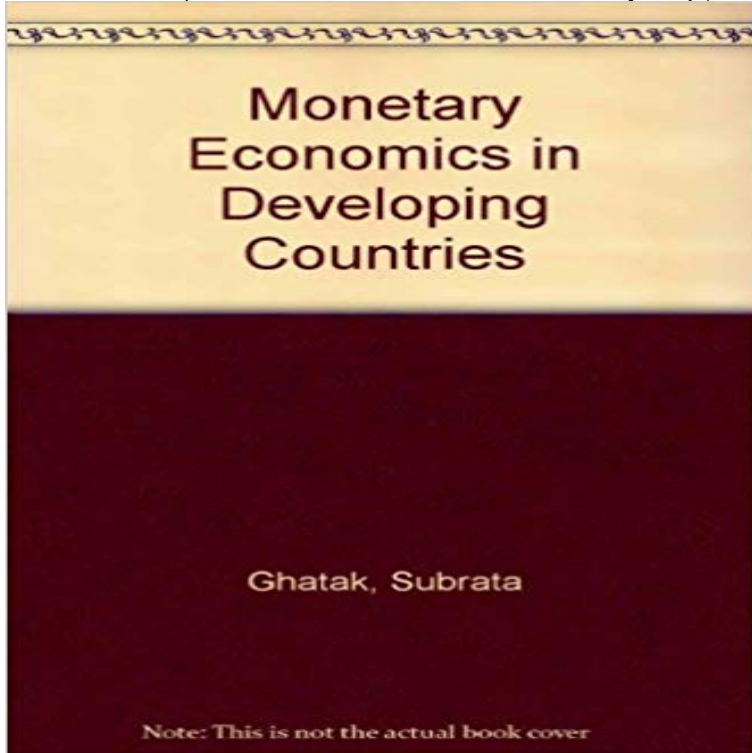


Monetary Economics in Developing Countries
